The Emerald Isle Camogie Club was founded in 1984. The affiliated with the American Camogie Association in 1985, but did not reach the Championship final that year. However, in 1986 they were crowned New England Senior Champions and in 1988 they also won that Division. That same year they won the North American Junior Camogie Championship.

In 1986 and 87, the Emerald Isle combined with two other Camogie Teams from New England to form the Boston Shamrocks and win the NACA Senior Championship final in 1986.

Winning the NACA Senior Championship Final again in 1992 and '93, the cup returned to Boston in '95 and would remain in the Emerald Isle Club. Unfortunately the Emerald Isles were runner up in 1998 Championship but again with true sportsmanship won the North East Championship and NACA Senior Championship in 1999. They are looking forward to defending their championship title and bringing the cup back to their Club for the year 2000.
